2025 CYMBAL SAUVIGNON BLANC COLUMBIA VALLEY

TASTING NOTES:

Vibrant and beautifully aromatic, the 2025 Cymbal opens with enticing notes of passion fruit and grapefruit, accented by delicate hints of honeysuckle and fresh herbs. The palate is bright and expressive, revealing layers of tropical fruit, Meyer lemon, and lemongrass supported by a refined mineral character. Crisp natural acidity brings energy and precision, carrying the wine through a refreshing, elegant finish.

VINTAGE:

The 2025 growing season delivered one of Washington's most balanced and straightforward vintages in recent memory. A mild winter and early, even bud break set the stage for healthy vine development, while a warm, steady summer free of extreme heat allowed the fruit to ripen gradually. Above-average September temperatures advanced harvest, and cooler conditions through October provided additional hang time, preserving vibrant acidity while developing concentrated flavors and expressive aromatics. The result is a vintage defined by remarkable purity, balance, and exceptional fruit quality.

WINEMAKING:

Handpicked grapes were gently whole cluster pressed to preserve fresh aromatics before settling for two to three days. The juice was then fermented in four distinct vessels: stainless steel and a concrete egg to retain vibrancy and minerality, neutral French oak to enhance aromatic complexity, and new French oak to build texture and richness through the mid-palate. The wine rested on its lees for six months prior to blending, developing added depth and elegance while maintaining its lively, fruit-driven character.

VINEYARDS:

The 2025 Cymbal is sourced from three exceptional Columbia Valley vineyards, each contributing a distinctive element to the blend. Old-vine Sauvignon Blanc from Bacchus Vineyard (66%) provides vibrant tropical fruit and aromatic intensity. Gamache Vineyard (20%) in the White Bluffs AVA brings bright acidity and notes of citrus and lemongrass, while McNary Vineyard (14%) in Horse Heaven Hills contributes texture, richness, and balance, resulting in a fresh and expressive Sauvignon Blanc.
