Walla Walla guests are invited to visit the winery and taste wines in the *Chihuly Tasting Room*, a beautifully appointed setting featuring glassworks by internationally acclaimed artist Dale Chihuly. The winery also welcomes a modern tasting room in Woodinville, opened in May 2023. Reservations at both locations are strongly encouraged. Drop-ins are welcome; however, appointments are limited.

The Inside Story

Begin in the Chihuly Tasting Room sampling a featured white wine, then head to the cellar for a barrel tasting and tour of our production facility. Afterward, sample five of our current releases accompanied by a charcuterie board and finish with a tasting of a special, limited release wine. Allow 90 minutes.

About Chihuly Long Shadows' founder Allen Shoup was as passionate about art as he was wine, and the Chihuly Tasting Room (1,075 sq. ft.) reflects Allen's ongoing commitment to both. An art collector himself, Allen and artist Dale Chihuly began a friendship in the mid-1980s that eventually led to the Chateau Ste. Michelle Artist Series and later a collaboration on Long Shadows' Walla Walla tasting room.

Macchias – two sets of three (six in total) displayed to create the impression of a field of wildflowers
“Blue Ridge Tall Grass” – another custom-designed installation inspired by the green wheat fields and Blue Ridge Mountains that provide a backdrop to the art
Painting – a gift from Chihuly. When Dale presented it to Allen on his first visit to the winery, the painting’s palette matched the winery’s colors perfectly to both their surprise.

About the Artist Dale Chihuly is an internationally renowned glass artist and Pacific Northwest native, largely credited with turning glassblowing into a serious art form. He has been the subject of many books, critical essays and PBS specials. Chihuly glass sculptures can be found in over 150 major museums around the world, including the Hokkaido Museum of Modern Art, the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Museum of Modern Art, the Louvre, the Victoria and Albert Museum, and the Whitney Museum.

	<p><u>Key Club Lounge</u> The Key Club Lounge is a private club room for the exclusive use of our Vault and Cellar Key Club members to enjoy a tasting or bottle in a relaxing, intimate setting. Hosted by a Long Shadows wine educator, guests will also have access to our library and club-only wines. The Key Club Lounge is available on a first-come basis.</p>
Interior	<p>Soaring 35-ft. ceilings, a double-sided, copper-cased fireplace, backlit bar with granite countertops, polished cement floors with large area rugs, and a grand piano create an inspired, contemporary impression. Upholstered chairs and leather sofas provide seating on the first floor. Sliding glass doors lead to the Key Club Lounge, open exclusively to Long Shadows' wine club subscribers, and a private event room suitable for intimate dinners, curated tastings or business meetings.</p> <p>Upstairs, three firepits, heat lamps and plentiful seating invite guests to settle into the covered upper deck for a casual, outdoor tasting.</p>
